Describe the individual's duties relating to the accomplishment of this subcontracting program: Individual shall be responsible for assigning appropriate work elements to subcontractors for each Task Order, with a view to meeting the overall SDB goals. He will also be responsible for tracking the achievement of SDB goals.

8. Describe the efforts the Contractor will make to assure that small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged and women-owned small business concerns have an equitable opportunity to compete for subcontracts. Our proposed subcontractors have been preselected, and work will be assigned depending upon the nature and location of the work. We do not foresee a need for subcontractors to have to compete for the work.
9. The Contractor agrees that FAR Contract Clause 52.219-8, *Utilization of Small Business Concerns*, will be included in all subcontracts that offer further subcontracting opportunities, and that the Contractor will require all subcontractors (except small business concerns) who receive subcontracts in excess of \$1,000,000 to adopt a subcontracting plan that complies with the requirements of FAR Clause 52.219-9.
10. The Contractor agrees to cooperate in any studies or surveys as may be required; submit *Standard Form (SF) 294; Subcontracting Report for Individual Contracts, and Standard Form (SF) 295, Summary Subcontract Report*, in accordance with the instructions on the forms and ensure that its subcontractors agree to submit SF 294 and SF 295. SF 294 shall be submitted semiannually and at contract completion. SF 295 shall be submitted annually at the close of each fiscal year (30 Sept).
11. The Contractor agrees to maintain records to demonstrate procedures adopted to comply with the requirements and goals of this plan. These records shall describe the Contractor's efforts to locate small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged and women-owned small business

- b. Provide adequate and timely consideration of the potentialities of small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged and women-owned small business concerns in all "make-or-buy" decisions.
 - c. Counsel and discuss subcontracting opportunities with representatives of small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged, and women-owned business firms.
 - d. Provide notice to subcontractors concerning penalties and remedies for misrepresentations of business status as small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged, or women-owned small business for the purpose of obtaining a subcontract that is to be included as part or all of a goal contained in this subcontracting plan.
13. The Contractor acknowledges that a failure of the Contractor or subcontractor to comply in good faith with clause 52.219-8, *Utilization of Small Business Concerns*, or this approved subcontracting plan shall be considered a material breach of the contract.
